

SPINAL CORD INJURY IBERIAN SYMPOSIUM 2015

ORAL PRESENTATIONS TRAVEL GRANTS' REGULATIONS

1. Grants will be awarded by the Symposium organisation, sponsored by Santa Casa da Misericórdia de Lisboa, to support the attendance of researchers to the 1st Spinal cord Injury Iberian Symposium.
2. Candidates must apply on-line by filling in the form at the symposium site <http://scis.org.pt>, until September 30, 2015.
3. It is mandatory for work submitted to focus on SCI or relevant fields.
4. Grants are meant for young researchers, namely:
 - Post-graduation students who are taking a masters degree or a PhD;
 - Post-doctoral researchers (with no more than 3 years passing since obtaining the degree).
5. Only one member per work submitted will be accepted.
6. Candidates will have to submit a no longer than 3 pages curriculum résumé; a letter from the supervisor confirming the student status; address and affiliation.
7. The amount will be up to 300€ (three hundred euros) per grant, depending on geographic location, upon presentation of travel expenses per person. Documents with expenses paid by more than one beneficiary or expenses of another beneficiary will not be accepted. Only travel and hotel expenses will be reimbursed.

9. The names of the Grant beneficiaries will be published on the symposium site: <http://scis.org.pt> before October 30th, 2015.
10. 30 grants will be awarded.
11. Work presented at the Symposium will be available for publishing or dissemination by any other means, to the organising institutions, always minding its authorship.
12. Situations not foreseen in these regulations will be decided by the Symposium's Organising Committee.
